

PDP Do-It-Yourself Enrollment Toolkit

This guide will walk you step-by-step through enrolling in a Prescription Drug Plan (PDP) yourself using Medicare.gov. It includes:

Step 1: Gather Your Information

Before starting, have the following ready:

- Your Medicare card (with your Medicare number and Parts A/B effective dates)
- A list of your prescription medications, including dosage and frequency
- Your preferred pharmacy or pharmacies
- A valid email address (if you want to receive plan information electronically)

Step 2: Access Medicare.gov

1. Go to: Medicare.gov
2. Click "Health & Drug Plans" then, "Find health & drug plans"

Step 3: Enter Your Information

1. Enter your ZIP code.
2. Confirm all information asked.
3. Answer the questions about any help you get with costs (Medicaid, Extra Help, etc.).
4. Enter your medications exactly as they appear on your prescription bottles to avoid cost discrepancies.
5. Select your preferred pharmacies to avoid cost discrepancies.

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Step 4: Compare Plans

1. Review the list of available plans.
2. Compare:
 - Monthly premium
 - Annual deductible
 - Copays/coinsurance for your medications
 - Copays/coinsurance for your doctor visits
 - Inpatient hospital stay costs
 - Pharmacy network

Step 5: Enroll in a Plan

1. Once you've selected a plan, click "Enroll".
2. Complete the enrollment form with your personal, contact, and Medicare information.
3. Review your application before submitting.

Step 6: Save Your Confirmation

- Print or save your confirmation page.
- Medicare will send you a letter confirming your enrollment.
